1. **Get an EPA ID number online:** www.dtsc.ca.gov/idmanifest/id_numbers.cfm
2. **Call 1-800-433-5060 before September 17th to schedule an appointment** and receive an estimate of your disposal costs.
3. Bring your hazardous materials and payment at your appointed time to the Del Norte County Transfer Station at 1700 State St. in Crescent City on Friday September 20, 2013.
